This one-day event is designed to help high-school aged rangatahi explore real-world career pathways in the music industry, both on stage and behind the scenes. Gig Starters Workshop

In this workshop students will learn about the practical side of putting on a live show.

The workshop features a panel discussion, Q&A session, and a hands-on walk through of a live soundcheck. Students will then get to watch the band perform.

In this session a panel of musicians and music industry professionals will discuss their jobs.

Students will have the opportunity to meet with panellists for short 1:1 conversations, where they can ask for tailored career advice and guidance on pathways into the industry.
